The center Cnam Madagascar

Created in Madagascar since 2003, the centre Cnam Madagascar offers the training courses listed in the national catalogue of the Cnam, and is aimed at a wide audience of baccalaureat holders and students.

The centre Cnam Madagascar is expanding its areas of intervention and training tools to better meet the needs of the local economy, by:

- Diversification of training offers (fields of study);
- Expanding through the use of validation systems: VAE (validation of acquired experience), VAPP (validation of professional and personal achievements), VES (validation of higher education);
- The development of its own contents, according to its own needs;
- The development of partnerships with the Malagasy authorities and French institutions established in Madagascar.

Main disciplines

About thirty disciplines are open in the fields of construction, information technology, innovation, accounting, or strategy ... (see the list), and are taught in French.

Students can continue their studies at the Cnam in France. The center Cnam Madagascar collaborates in particular with:

- The International Institute of Management of the Cnam (IIM) for the Master in Management (MIM);
- The National Institute of Economic and Accounting Techniques of the Cnam (INTEC), for accounting training from the DGC (accountant), DSGC to the DEC (chartered accountant).

Strong points

- · Online and/or hybrid courses;
- Online registration facilitating access to the courses;

- Updated training offers that meet the needs of companies;
- Teaching staff from the professional world who take turns each year to provide hybrid courses, seminars or short courses in companies;
- Validation of acquired experience (VAE) and validation of higher education (VES);
- · Continuation of studies in France.

Degrees awarded

The diplomas and titles awarded range from professional certifications to master's degrees and engineering:

- national diplomas: the general bachelor's degree, the master's degree...;
- establishment diplomas including professional certificates, certificates of competence, and certificates of specialization;
- engineer title
- INTEC-Cnam diplomas: DGC (accountant), DSGC to the DEC (chartered accountant)

Cnam Madagascar has 708 students enrolled in the following areas:

- 23% in the field of Computer Science;
- 33% in the field of Innovation (Management, Human Resources...);
- 6% in the field of Accounting;
- 25% in the field of Strategy (e.g. Commerce);
- 13% in the field of construction.

French as a foreign language courses (FLE)

- All of the programs are in French.
- Thanks to the center's partnership with the Alliance Française d'Antananarivo, students can strengthen their French language skills.
